TRAINING

- Initial training induction (4-hours on one Sunday in Melbourne CBD).
- Throughout the year, training/practice sessions run every 2 weeks on Sunday 10am-1pm in a hybrid model (some sessions are held online over zoom and some in person depending on the session objectives)
- A total of 15 hours of training/practice sessions (attendance at 5 sessions) is required before facilitators are qualified to deliver workshops.

WORKSHOPS

- Once the training requirement is reached, time commitment is flexible. However, facilitators are expected to be available for a **minimum of 2 weekdays**, as this is when we deliver workshops in schools

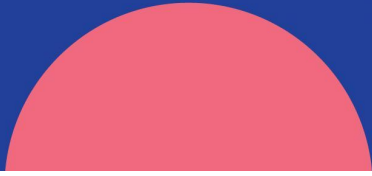
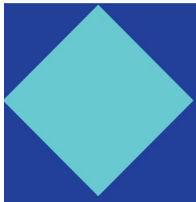
